5.1 President						
Regular Play	Our main activity currently revolves around a single BBO session per week. It seems likely that face to face bridge will not resume for at least several months. These sessions now run reasonably smoothly thanks to the great contribution of Eric Lam. The main issues are:					
	Delays in registration of new players (this is done externally from our club)					
	Slow uptake by members not familiar with computer systems.					
	These sessions have allowed our members to maintain contact with one another, but a single session is not sufficient.					
	I have made contact with Ross Mulholland of Pennant Hills Bridge Club and Ross was very helpful indicating the way their session was working on Monday mornings. Our members are invited to join this and we have circulated this advice to members. These are paid sessions (I believe \$3BBO per session). We will need to consider expanding our on-line offering to our members and this could involve an additional session possibly along the lines of the Carlingford Monday sessions. This may give us greater direct control of registration.
