#### 6.1. Grand National Novice Pairs Event Plan

This event runs over 3 weeks, for Novice players (anyone under 100MPs) and must be a home member of PBC. Heats are next week, and we will offer red points. We will run the heat on Real Bridge. Entry fee = \$10 per person. Top 4 go into the semi-finals. Others can enter if they choose — and can compete in multiple events (\$5 for each session). The committee should all re-read the brochure and come back to Sandy with questions for the organisers tomorrow morning.
